

TREE REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT LANDSCAPE SUMMARY

Work Completed:

Autumn Oaks Tree Service removed 11 Austrian Pines, 3 Box Elders, and 5 additional (previously cut) stumps (19 stumps total) on 9/18 for a total cost of \$1,595.00.

Work Proposed:

After contacting and/or visiting several landscape nurseries (including Shemin, Geist, Landmark, Allisonville, and NI, I've concluded Seasons Gardens of Fishers will give us the best results and selection of plants for our money. Additionally, the following installation will be overseen by their staff landscape architect.

1. Beginning at the north end of Foxchase (nearest Mudcreek Road), we will be creating a mulched planting bed containing 3 Viburnum and 6 Gracillimus (ornamental grass) plants on top of the swale. We will also be planting a 3-inch October Glory maple tree approximately 25 feet behind the swale as a backdrop.
2. All area where trees & stumps were remove will be dug out and have top soil, grass seed, and fiber matting (for erosion control) installed. Note: Will not include small stump removal area south of entrance.
3. Continuing south, we will be planting 2 Colorado Select Blue Spruces and 1 Siberian Spruce between existing trees and evergreens along the swale.
4. On the south end of the swale (north of the drainage ditch), we will be creating another small bed containing 3 Holley bushes and 3 dwarf fountain grass plants, which are shade tolerant.
5. South of the drainage ditch, we will be replacing the lawn areas only (per item 2).

Note: All trees, evergreens, & other plants have been hand-selected by me and are on hold for Foxchase pending job approval.

Total proposed cost including plants & installation (with 1-year plant guarantee), and tax:
